



Restoration & Refurbishment of a Sir Christopher Wren designed Church in the heart of the City of London.

The work comprised internal restoration and conservation of wall and ceiling horse hair plaster work, together with complete redecoration of internal surfaces featuring gold leaf work on period features.

Commemorative plaques were taken down, restored and replaced following extensive repairs to water damaged structural fabric.

The work was carried out on a complete internal birdcage scaffolding system which had to be erected and dismantled extremely carefully around the historic church joinery and carpentry fittings.

Additional work was carried out to build a new kitchen and w.c. extension within the rear graveyard area, to suit the listed building structure and fabric.
